

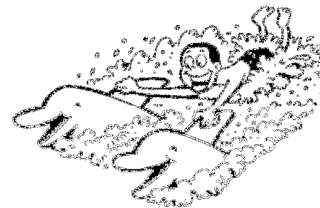

The Rules

Welcome to the Monona Public Library's Summer Reading Program!

- Please read books checked out from the Monona Library.
- Read books which are at or above your current reading level!
- Include time spent reading books, magazines, newspapers, listening to books on CD.
- Bring your reading record to the Monona Library to *collect prizes!*
- If you lose your reading record, check with us at the Reading Adventure desk.



KEEP TRACK OF YOUR READING

1. By the title of the book you read *OR*
2. By the time you spend listening to books read aloud, or books on compact disc *OR*
3. A combination of titles and time.

PARENTS

Please initial the reading record for each section your child completes.

The focus of the Summer Reading Program is to recognize your child's independent reading by helping them find books they love. You can also read *to* your child.

Reading just 6 books in the summer will keep your child at or above their reading level when they return to school in the fall.

When choosing books, be sure that they are just right – not too hard and not too easy.



COLLECT READING INCENTIVES

Come to the Monona Library to collect prizes while supplies last.

Coupons have individual expiration dates.

The first day to collect prizes is June 16. Last day to collect prizes is July 30.

OVERTIME PRIZES

Earn tickets to enter a random drawing for even more prizes by continuing to record your reading on Overtime Tickets after you complete this reading record.
